WREN

LITERACY

In Literacy we have been practising to write our name.

- We have been practising to read our names.
- We have been looking at the letters in our name, discussing what they are called.
- We have talked about how each letter is formed.
- We have followed an outline of our name, working on the formation of each letter.

READING

In reading we have been sharing information about a picture.

- We have been looking at pictures of familiar characters.
- We have been discussing what we know about the characters – Kipper, Biff and Chip.
- We have been looking for clues in the pictures to tell us more.

MATHEMATICS

In mathematics we have been learning about the number and amount 2.

- We have been talking about the Twoness of 2.
- We looked at what the amount 2 looks like.
- We did actions and movements using 2.
- We looked at how you would record the digit 2.
- We also talked about what is one more and one less than 2.

PHONICS

In Phonics, we have been learning about the phonemes (sounds) – s,a,t

- We have been looking at our mouths, seeing and listening how these phonemes are formed.
- We have been discussing each grapheme, finding their place in the alphabet.
- We have been reading different words beginning with these phonemes.
- We have used our blending skills to work out each word.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

In P.E, we have continued to work on our balancing skills. We can now make a balance using the side of our body and with our hands and legs in the air. We worked on travelling and jumping off of equipment. We tried to keep our balance.

We have been talking about the words – past, present and future. We talked about how we were in the past and if we had changed. We loved sharing our baby photos, guessing who was who. We discussed how we had changed. We discussed what we might look like in the future.

We have been painting our self-portraits. We have been looking in a mirror to look at our features, finding the correct colours to paint.
