Planned Y5 Educational Visits

11/12/25 and 12/12/25 – (classes split between days) Leeds Museum and Galleries / Royal Armouries Leeds

Year 5 children will be visiting Leeds Museum and Galleries as part of their topic learning about 'Ancient Greece'. A visit to Museum and Galleries is a fantastic opportunity for the pupils to gain first hand experience of working with artefacts.

How this links to our children's learning:

- History curriculum: children will immerse themselves in this civilization by coming face-to-face with surviving Ancient Greek pottery and riches.
- Children will learn about conducting themselves in public, public speaking and safety in public.
