Dear Year 6 Parents and Carers,

Thank you very much to the 63 parents and carers who completed last half term's survey about the Year 6 end-of-year celebrations. We really appreciate your feedback and the time you took to share your views.

I am pleased to let you know the outcomes of the survey:

- 65% of respondents voted for a disco and buffet, so this will be our plan for the Year 6 celebration event in school.
- 63% of respondents also voted for school to contribute towards the cost of the celebratory visit to Gulliver's, while 38% voted for the school to subsidise the cost of leavers' hoodies instead.

As a result, we will go with the majority view and contribute towards the cost of the visit to Gulliver's. This does mean that we will not be facilitating leavers' hoodies this year.

I understand that some families may be disappointed with this decision. As many of you are aware, public sector finances — particularly for schools — are extremely tight, and unfortunately, we can't fund every option. The majority of responses showed a clear preference for the Gulliver's visit, and we feel this will be a memorable and enjoyable experience for the children to share together.
