Planned Y4 Educational Visits

We have planned educational visits for Y4 children for this academic year. We hope that by sending this information out early in the year, it helps you to plan ahead. We appreciate that parents need more time to plan given the cost-of-living crisis currently impacting on all our finances. Educational visits not only offer learning to strengthen curriculum knowledge, but they also help to improve children's social and emotional wellbeing, as well as offering them a wide variety of experiences.

Date – Gainsborough Old Hall November(tbd)

Year 4 children will be visiting Gainsborough Old Hall as part of their topic learning about 'The Tudors. A visit to a historical building is a fantastic opportunity for the pupils to experience life as a Tudor.

How this links to our children's learning:

- History curriculum: children will see the magnificent medieval great hall, the domestic apartments and the finest medieval kitchen complex anywhere in England to support their understanding of the period.
- Art: Children will see first hand authentic portraits from Tudor artists.
- Children will learn about conducting themselves in public, public speaking and safety in public.
